On 30 August, Culture Arcade opens at the Prince Claus Fund Gallery in Amsterdam. Culture Arcade is an interactive exhibition and game room, featuring games with cultural themes that offer creative insights into the value of cultural heritage around the world. Also exhibited in Culture Arcade are sci-fi works by Omar Gilani, a young digital artist from Pakistan, whose imagination takes his country into a fantasy future.
